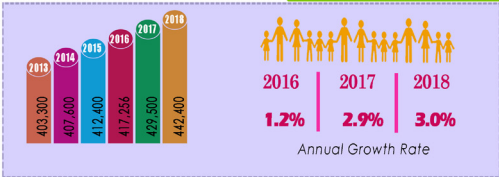

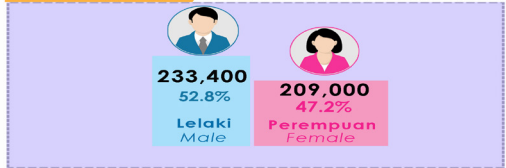


POPULATION 2018

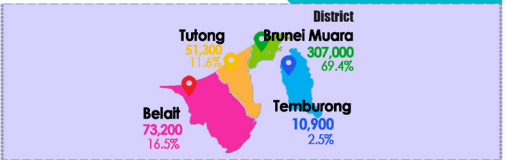
Population Trend

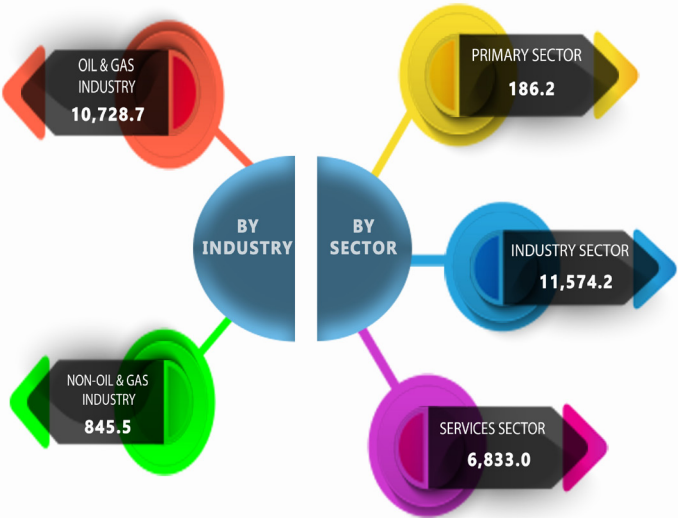
