**INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), JUN 2014**

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1. Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan Jun 2014 meningkat 0.4 peratus berbanding Mei 2014.
2. Peningkatan sebanyak 1.0 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi Pengangkutan disebabkan oleh kos yang tinggi pada perkhidmatan pengangkutan udara. Pakaian dan Kasut meningkat 3.6 peratus disebabkan oleh harga yang tinggi bagi kebanyakan pakaian dan kasut. Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah juga meningkat sebanyak 0.8 peratus disebabkan oleh harga yang tinggi bagi kebanyakan tekstil, peralatan isi rumah, barangan kaca, pinggan mangkuk, kelengkapan isi rumah serta dan barangan isi rumah yang tidak tahan lama.
3. Sementara itu, penurunan sebanyak 0.7 peratus telah dicatatkan bagi indeks Rekreasi dan Kebudayaan disebabkan oleh harga yang rendah bagi komputer dan aksesori komputer yang terpilih, permainan dan hobi serta pakej percutian/umrah.
4. IHP bagi Jun 2014 meningkat 0.2 peratus berbanding Jun 2013 yang mana sebahagian besarnya disebabkan oleh peningkatan indeks Pengangkutan; Restoran dan Hotel; dan Pendidikan.

5. IHP ini adalah petunjuk bagi mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa tertentu. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berasaskan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga yang diperolehi melalui Kajian Perbelanjaan Keluarga. **CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), JUNE 2014**

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1. *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for June 2014 increased by 0.4 per cent over May 2014.*
2. *An increase of 1.0 per cent was recorded in Transport due to higher cost of passenger transport services by air. Clothing and Footwear increased by 3.6 per cent due to higher prices of several selected garments as well as shoes and other footwear. Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance increased by 0.8 per cent due to higher cost of household textiles, household appliances, glassware, tableware and household utensils as well as non-durable household goods.*
3. *On the other hand, a decrease of 0.7 per cent was recorded in Recreation and Culture due to lower prices of selected computer and computers accessories, games, toys and hobbies as well as package holidays/pilgrimages.*
4. *CPI for June 2014 increased by 0.2 per cent compared to June 2013, largely due to higher index for Transport; Restaurants and Hotels; and Education.*

5. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
