**INDEKS HARGA PENGGUNA (IHP), SEPTEMBER 2016**

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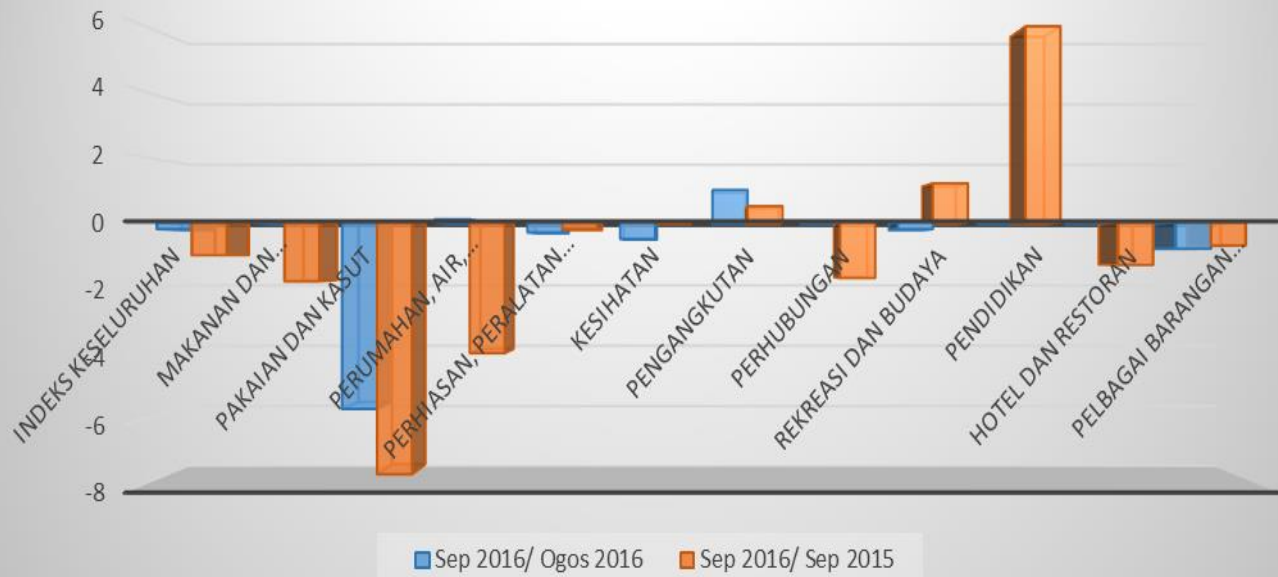
1. Jabatan Perancangan dan Kemajuan Ekonomi, Jabatan Perdana Menteri hari ini mengumumkan bahawa Indeks Harga Pengguna (IHP) bagi bulan September 2016 menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus berbanding Ogos 2016, yang mana Indeks Makanan dan Minuman Ringan dan Indeks Bukan Makanan masing-masing mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.2 peratus dan 0.1 peratus. Berbanding dengan tahun lepas, IHP bagi September 2016 menurun sebanyak 1.0 peratus.
2. Penurunan Indeks keseluruhan bagi bulan September 2016 berbanding bulan Ogos 2016 adalah disebabkan terutamanya oleh penurunan-penurunan Indeks Pakaian dan Kasut sebanyak 5.7 peratus, Indeks Pelbagai Barangan dan Perkhidmatan sebanyak 0.8 peratus dan Indeks Perhiasan, Peralatan Isi Rumah dan Penyelenggaraan Rutin Isi Rumah sebanyak 0.3 peratus.
3. Daripada 11 divisyen indeks utama, dua indeks mencatatkan peningkatan iaitu Indeks Pengangkutan sebanyak 1.0 peratus dan Indeks Perumahan, Air, Elektrik, Gas dan Bahan Bakar Lain sebanyak 0.1 peratus. Ini adalah disebabkan oleh peningkatan-peningkatan harga pengangkutan penumpang melalui udara dan harga bagi barangan untuk penyelenggaraan dan pembaikan kediaman.
4. Manakala Indeks Perhubungan, Pendidikan dan Hotel dan Restoran tidak mengalami sebarang perubahan.
5. IHP mengukur perubahan harga barangan dan perkhidmatan yang dibayar oleh pengguna dalam satu tempoh masa ditetapkan dan dikumpulkan setiap bulan. Senarai barangan dan perkhidmatan dalam IHP adalah berdasarkan maklumat perbelanjaan purata sebuah keluarga

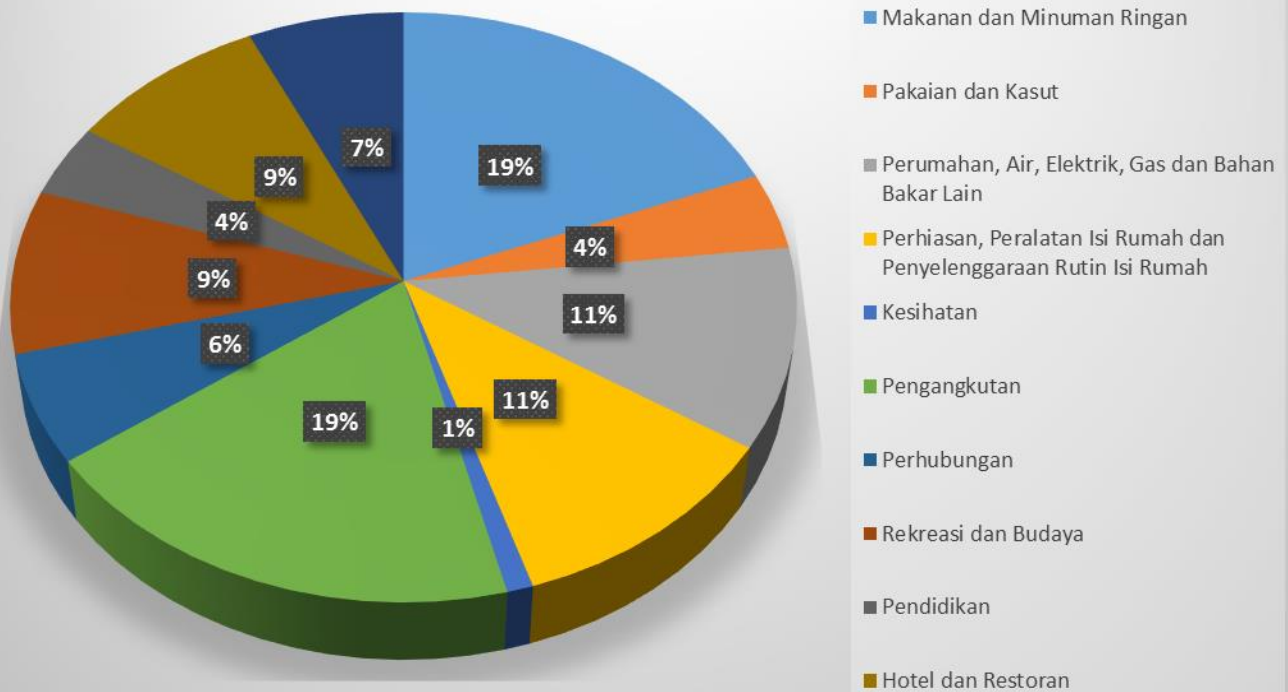

**CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI), SEPTEMBER 2016**

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1. The Department of Economic Planning and Development, Prime Minister's Office today announces that *The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in September 2016 fell by 0.2 per cent over August 2016, whereby the Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages and Non-Food Index both decreased by 0.1 per cent and 0.2 per cent, respectively. Compared to last year, the CPI for September 2016 has decreased by 1.0 per cent.*
2. *The fall in overall CPI in September was mainly attributed to the fall in Clothing and Footwear Index, which decreased by 5.7 per cent, Miscellaneous Goods and Services Index by 0.8 per cent and Furnishings, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance Index by 0.3 per cent.*
3. *On the other hand, of the 11 major divisions, only two indices recorded an increase; Transport Index which rose by 1.0 per cent resulting from higher cost of passenger transport by air, and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels Index by 0.1 per cent, owing to higher cost of maintenance and repair of dwellings.*
4. *Meanwhile, indices for Communication; Education and Restaurants and Hotels remained unchanged.*
5. *CPI is a measure of price changes of goods and services paid by the consumer in a specified period and compiled on a monthly basis. The list of goods and services in the CPI is based on the average expenditure per household from the Household Expenditure Survey.
